Operations may begin only following the issuance of a certificate, license or permit which will be issued once compliance is made with the following requirements which are explained in the Code of Federal Regulations or with any other conditions imposed.

It is ordered:

Final Authority will not be issued unless within 180 days applicant complies with the applicable requirements set forth below before the final authority will be issued.

Motor Common Carrier: (1) Insurance (liability: ICC form BMC-91 or BMC-91X and cargo: ICC form BMC-34); (49 CFR 1043); (2) Designation of agents upon whom process may be served (ICC form BOC-3) (49 CFR 1044); and (3) Passenger and household goods carriers must also file tariffs or schedules (49 CFR 1312).

Motor Contract Carrier: (1) Insurance (liability: ICC form BMC-91 or BMC-91X) (49 CFR 1043); (2) Designation of agents upon whom process may be served (ICC form BOC-3) (49 CFR 1044); and (3) Passenger carriers must also file tariffs or schedules (49 CFR 1312), or submit a petition seeking exemption of this requirement. Service must be performed under a continuing agreement with one or more persons.

Broker: (1) Insurance (surety bond: ICC form BMC-84 or trust fund agreement: BMC-85 (49 CFR 1043); and designation of agents upon whom process may be served (ICC form BOC-3) (49 CFR 1044).

Freight Forwarder: (1) Insurance (liability: ICC form BMC-91 or BMC-91X and cargo: ICC form BMC-34) (49 CFR 1084); and (2) Designation of agents (ICC form BOC-3) (49 CFR 1044).

Water Common Carrier: (1) Tariffs or schedules (49 CFR 1312).

If applicant fails to comply with the conditions set forth in the grant of authority within 180 days from the service date of this decision, the application shall stand dismissed for want of prosecution.
